The Education Minor is designed to provide the non-education major with the professional skills and knowledge supportive of job descriptions in vocations linked to education such as social services, juvenile justice, and recreation. The minor is conceived as a broad introduction to key elements in the core of contemporary education, excluding curriculum. The course of study does not provide certification to teach and education majors are not eligible to pursue the minor.

The Education Minor requires 15 sh of upper division course work of which 9 sh must be completed at UWF. All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Students pursuing the minor must meet with an undergraduate advisor in Professional Studies Student Center prior to registering for courses. Lower division prerequisites may be waived by the advisors in the Professional Studies Student Center (PSSC) or the Chairperson, Division of Teacher Education.
