The Education Minor is designed to provide the non-education major with the professional skills and knowledge supportive of job descriptions in vocations linked to education such as high school teaching, social services, juvenile justice, and recreation. The minor is conceived as a broad introduction to key elements in the core of contemporary education, excluding curriculum. The course of study does not directly provide certification to teach and traditional teacher education majors are not eligible to pursue the minor.

The Education Minor requires 15 sh of upper division course work of which 9 sh must be completed at UWF. All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. Students pursuing the minor must meet with an undergraduate advisor prior to registering for courses. Lower division prerequisites may be waived by the advisor or the Chairperson, Division of Teacher Education. Upper division course substitutions allowed with the permission of the chairperson, Division of Teacher Education.
